ALL SPORTS BOOSTER CLUB MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 10, 2014 -- 6:30 pm

1. Approval of Aug. minutes, two amendments; Heidi McGraw made the request to have the club sponsor volleyball backpacks for the team. Also, BZ Kayser made the request to have the club sponsor the payment for referees for their soccer tournament, at a cost of \$480. Motion to approve as amended by Ed Scaro, Seconded by JoAnne Schafer.
2. Financial Report was reviewed along with fair parking results. Motion to accept report as submitted, Shelly Higgins, seconded by Steve Constable.
3. Additional items brought up by Eric Larsen:
  - a. Volleyball pack backs were \$175 more than the original motion. Motion to pay this additional amount, Dave Welsh, seconded by Shelly Higgins.
  - b. Water bottle purchase was \$65.18 more than the original motion. Motion to pay this additional amount, Dave Welsh, seconded by Shelly Higgins.
  - c. Cash register purchase was \$75 more than the original motion. Motion to pay this additional amount, JoAnn Schafer, seconded by Dave Welsh.
4. Discussion on ordering polo shirts with the new booster club logo was discussed. Motion to make an initial order of those attending ordering shirts plus 4 XL, 4 L, and 4 M for the club to sell out of the concessions stand. Price not to exceed \$900. Motion by Ed Scaro, seconded by Steve Constable.
5. Fair Parking was discussed, general sense was that it went well, had one bad day Monday, which was way down, other than that all good. Other items as follows:
  - a. Eric Larsen will look into the cost of three, fold up tents to be used for fair parking and other EAHS events, tents will have the Booster Club Name on them.
  - b. Ed Scaro will look into additional signage costs and up-grading the portable sign.
  - c. Additional cones for spots 18A & B.
  - d. Dave Welsh volunteered to be Chair for next year's parking event.
  - e. An adult needs to be at the reserved area starting at 8:00 a.m. every day.
  - f. In our write up of instructions for fair parking, we need to instruct people how to fill up the parking lot.
6. Dean Wilson gave the AD up-date:
  - a. There will be a winter mandatory student/parent meeting (just like the one done in fall), date to be determined.
  - b. General discussion of new teaching schedule of one additional class being taught by each teacher. May bring new opportunities for weight room usage.
  - c. Jason Taddlock and two other school board members will be invited to our next meeting to understand the direction of the current board with respect to athletics.

7. Shelly Higgins gave the concession report:
  - a. Very busy since the new year started, 12 events so far and doing very well.
  - b. Prices on many items have been increased.
  - c. We will need additional bodies to help during the football homecoming. Ed Scaro and Ward Phillips have volunteered to help.
8. It was decided that the Club will wait to hear what the school board representative's state regarding "their direction" on athletics, prior to the Club making a decision on whether to pay down our long term debt to the District.
9. It was decided that we will again do a 50/50 raffle at the football homecoming game, Ed and Ward will sell tickets.
