### **OLD BUSINESS**

Website- Dave presented quotes from two businesses, Whiteboard Development and Signal Fire. First one was \$800 for initial set up and \$9.17 monthly. Signal Fire was for \$2200. Discussion followed as to what we wanted on the site, who would update, and any other costs. Whiteboard example websites looked nice. Questions arose as to would we have 1 or 2 people able to update the site or could we email Whiteboard and have them update site. More discussion next month.

Golf Outing - This is the 20<sup>th</sup> year so if anyone has any ideas let Ed know. Ed would like to have the person who started the event recognized. Need to go through old minutes to find name. We will partner with the Rotary again this year and Peoples Bank will be the big sponsor. The outing is June 13<sup>th</sup> so begin finding golfers. Ed will have flyer in next newsletter which Ward will put out soon.

Poster schedule – Cost from Advanced Printing would be \$55 set up and then save and change each season. Two options, poster with season schedule and poster with each sport was discussed. Also, should Booster Club pay total (our new logo on it) or split with each sport. More discussion next month.

By-Laws – Discuss of revised by-laws. Need further discussion next month as well as voting on dues. Shall we have yearly, 4 year, and lifetime? How much? Also need a written standard procedure for the president as to what is to be discussed each month and how often the newsletter needs to go out (monthly or quarterly).

### **NEW BUSINESS**

We received a thank you card for the 5<sup>th</sup> grade basketball team for letting them use our concession stand during their tournament. They each signed it which was a nice thought.

### **ATHLETIC DIRECTOR**

Dean said the winter banquet went very well. Rotary did a nice job. Golf team does not need to pay the \$80 fee per golfer. They are going back to the old way of collecting a check from each golfer and if they do not put in their required volunteer time then the check will be cashed. Otherwise at the end of the season their check is returned/destroyed. Todd Hanson is preparing the fence for the softball field. It should be ready by the first game which is Tuesday April 8<sup>th</sup>. Tuesday's home track meet has already been cancelled due to cold weather. Other spring sports are just getting under way.
